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Polarman's Camp & Snow Igloo Park Live

Step into the magic of Lapland, just 10 minutes from Levi, where a secluded private camp opens to a nearly 360° unobstructed sky - no crowds, no light pollution, only warmth and wonder.

Begin with a welcome from the Polarman, settle by the open fire on reindeer skins, listen to authentic Arctic stories, and explore the camp's unique attractions. Join the Aurora Hunt - a guided riverwalk in search of the Northern Lights. Capture the moment with our professional camera, framed by the magical arctic scenery.

Step into the Snow Igloo Park, built from late November onward, featuring a grand igloo, Inuit igloos, a snow maze, children's snowslide, and more. Relax in the warm Aurora dome (+15°C), enjoy hot drinks, cookies, and a 20-minute movie on Lapland's seven seasons. End your evening with an outdoor Lappish BBQ, roasting sausages and marshmallows around the fire beneath the northern sky.

Our staff will alert you to any Aurora appearances, capturing photos you'll treasure forever.

Blue Moment at Polarman's Camp - Early Evening Winter Experience

Experience the Blue Moment at Polarman's Camp, an exclusive early evening Arctic adventure on private land just 10 minutes from Levi. Beneath the deep kaamos twilight, the snowy landscape, illuminated igloos and surrounding forest take on a rare blue glow that feels completely different from full darkness.

With earlier departures, this family-friendly experience includes everything from the evening program. Explore the hand-built Snow Igloo Park with carved archways, tunnels, igloos, sculptures, a snow maze and children's snow slide. Inside the main igloo, join the Polarman's Arctic survival presentation before setting out on a guided walk through the private winter wilderness.

Warm up anytime in the heated Aurora Dome (+15°C), gather around the fire for a traditional Lappish BBQ with sausages and marshmallows, and listen to authentic Arctic stories. Staff monitor the skies throughout the experience and alert guests if the Northern Lights appear. A professional photo session runs throughout the experience, with images delivered to you afterwards.

The route is adjusted throughout the evening according to cloud cover, wind direction and visibility. Even when the sky is partially cloudy, there's still a chance to catch glimpses of the magical Northern Lights.

Stops along the way invite you to pause beneath the northern sky with warm berry juice and traditional gingerbread cookies. Local knowledge, carefully chosen viewing locations and a touch of luck combine to create a memorable evening in Lapland.

This private adventure blends scenic drives, expert guidance and the excitement of searching for one of nature's most spectacular phenomena, making it perfect for anyone eager to witness the Arctic sky come alive.

Lappish Meeting with a Shaman in a Hut

Just 40 minutes from Levi, on the tranquil shore of Lake Jerisjärvi beside Pallas-Ylläs National Park, lives the Shaman of Jerisjärvi. A local figure preserving ancient northern traditions.

Inside a traditional Lappish kota, settle onto reindeer hides around an open fire. Stuffed ravens and a watchful boreal owl add to the mystery as the flames flicker and the Shaman enters backwards according to ritual custom. Dressed in fur, leather and animal skins, he shares an ancient tale, leads a ceremony of rhythmic drumming and symbolic gestures, and offers each guest a personal blessing.

The ceremony ends with fresh coffee brewed over the fire and blueberry pie made with the Shaman's own hand-picked berries. On clear evenings, the Aurora may appear above the lake and surrounding fells.

For daytime visits, an optional lunch can be added. After the ceremony, the Shaman's cousin Jari serves the meal by the fire as stories of local life, nature and tradition continue.

The Shaman is also available for off-site visits for groups or special occasions (lunch not included).

Lappish Evening with a Shaman in a Hut with dinner

Just 40 minutes from Levi, on the tranquil shore of Lake Jerisjärvi, beside Pallas-Ylläs National Park, lives the Shaman of Jerisjärvi. Inside a traditional Lappish kota, settle onto reindeer hides by the fire as he enters backwards according to ritual custom. Dressed in fur and leather, he shares ancient northern tales, leads a drumming ceremony and offers each guest a personal blessing.

Outside the Christmas high season, the evening may continue with dinner served by the Shaman's cousin Jari, in a more relaxed atmosphere. Choose from a festive reindeer menu, a festive fish menu featuring local pike or whitefish, or a lighter smoked reindeer stew. During the Christmas period, the experience is offered without dinner and end with fire-brewed coffee and homemade blueberry pie.

On clear evenings, the Aurora may appear above the lake and surrounding fells. The Shaman is also available for off-site visits for groups and special occasions, without dinner.

Traditional Winter Net Fishing & Fish Soup by the Fire

On the edge of Pallas-Ylläs National Park lies tranquil Lake Jerisjärvi, only 40 minutes from Levi. On its quiet shoreline in Keimionemi village, a local fisherman welcomes you into the timeless rhythm of life in Lapland.

Outfitted in warm winter gear, step onto the frozen lake amid pristine, snow-covered scenery. The fisherman introduces juomustus, an ancient method of winter net fishing once essential for survival, and shows how nets are laid beneath the ice using simple, traditional tools.

Then comes the moment of truth: the cork line trembles in your hands and silver whitefish glimmer beneath the ice. Jerisjärvi's clear waters are renowned for their rich whitefish catch, and the thrill captivates even first-time fishers.

Afterwards, retreat to the warmth of a traditional kota. By the open fire, enjoy freshly prepared fish soup, followed by fire-brewed coffee and homemade blueberry pie, while your host shares ancient legends and local tales passed down through generations.

More than a fishing excursion, this is a cultural journey into the heart of Lapland.

Traditional Summer Fishing in Lappish Lake Scenery & Smoked Whitefish Lunch by the Fire

Just 40 minutes from Levi, on the peaceful shores of Lake Jerisjärvi lies Keimiöniemi, home to Jari and his family, who have lived and fished here since the 1830s. This authentic summer experience invites you to discover traditional Lappish lake life in a magnificent natural setting.

Begin at Jari's home before walking to the shore and travelling by boat to the historic Keimiöniemi fishing huts. Jari, a master storyteller, shares tales of life by the lake, past and present.

Back on his private shore, you'll learn traditional seine fishing. The net is taken onto the lake in two boats and cast into the water. Some guests can join the fishermen on board, while others admire the fell scenery from a rowing boat or relax by the warming fire on shore.

When the fish turns copper in the smoke, enjoy it by hand for a truly traditional lakeside lunch. Finish with fire-brewed coffee and homemade blueberry pie made with berries handpicked by the family.

A genuine Lappish moment where history, nature and flavour come together.

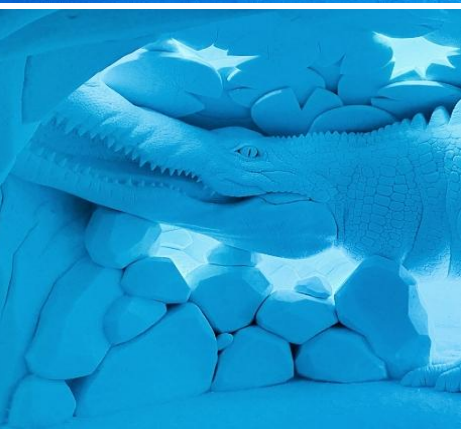

Visit to Lainio Snow Village

Just 40 minutes from Levi lies the enchanting Snow Village - an ephemeral world built anew each winter from snow and ice. On a guided tour you'll wander glittering corridors, themed chambers, dazzling sculptures, and the iconic ice bar. A warming juice awaits at the end, before time to explore freely at your own pace.

Each season unveils a new artistic theme: from Game of Thrones to Macro World, Futuristic, Around the World, Nordic Mythology, and Underworld.

Just 40 minutes from Levi, your evening begins with a three-course dinner in the spectacular Ice Restaurant - dining at sculpted tables and chairs within shimmering snow and ice. After dinner, a guided tour reveals the Snow Village: themed rooms, glittering corridors, dazzling sculptures, and the iconic ice bar, where warming juice is served. You'll then have time to explore at leisure before returning. Each year brings a new theme, from Game of Thrones to Macro World, Futuristic, Around the World, Nordic Mythology, and Underworld.

Dinner menu (2025-2026)*:

- Starters: Lapland delicacies in tapas style (reindeer, fish, farm cheese, vegetables, berries), cauliflower soup with apple & Västerbotten cheese, or scallops with citrus, pea & mint.

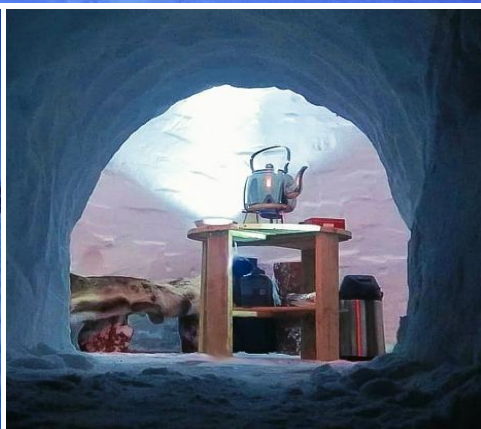

Build your own Snow Igloo (Winter survival in the wilderness masterclass)

Dressed in a thermal suit, safari boots and mittens, venture into the Arctic wilderness to a beautiful riverside or frozen lake. Here you'll learn how to survive a snowstorm the traditional way: by building a real snow igloo. Guided by a wilderness professional, your team works together with shovels to create a shelter while learning genuine Arctic survival skills. The program requires normal physical condition and moderate cold resistance, and can be run in nearly any winter weather.

Building sites are set in beautiful Lappish nature, and some igloos created during the program are later preserved in our Snow Igloo Park for visitors to admire. Your names and country may be displayed on the igloo's sign. Around the fire, enjoy warm drinks and snacks.

Optional: Arrive by snowmobile safari. After gearing up and a safety briefing, enjoy an exclusive 1.5–2-hour ride along private trails through snow-covered forests and frozen lakes before reaching the site. The experience ends with a car transfer back to your accommodation.

Created for experienced riders, this extended safari goes beyond the standard routes into the mountain wilderness of Kätkätunturi and Pyhätunturi. With no sleighs or children, the focus is on longer trails, varied terrain and the freedom to ride at a steady pace. Solo snowmobiles are strongly recommended to fully enjoy the power, control, and freedom this tour offers.

The route combines Levi's public trails with significant sections of privately owned wilderness land inaccessible to other operators. Once the trail enters private ground, other snowmobiles disappear, leaving open snow, forest and mountain terrain ahead.

Midway, pause at a private wilderness kota or remote café, depending on the route and conditions. Warm up with a hot drink and grilled sausage or a snack. Traditional Lappish soup with bread is available as an optional extra.

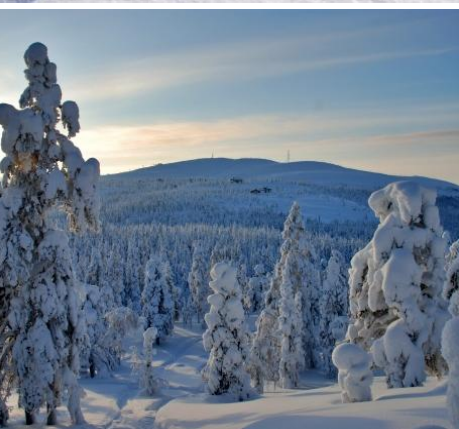

Designed for experienced single drivers, this is our most exclusive and technically demanding snowmobile adventure. This is the only safari that can take you to the 531 m summit of Levi Fell, where, on clear days, breathtaking views stretch all the way to the Swedish border.

Your journey begins at our private safari house, then continues along Levi's maintained trails and exclusive private wilderness routes through the Kätkätunturi and Pyhäntunturi mountain areas. As the forest gives way to open fell, the climb becomes increasingly challenging, rewarding skilled riders with one of Lapland's most spectacular snowmobile experiences. The summit ascent and descent demand full attention and complete control: no passengers, no shared machines.

Midway, pause at a private wilderness kota or remote wilderness café to enjoy a hot drink with grilled sausage or a snack before continuing your adventure. If weather or snow conditions prevent the summit ascent, the safari follows an extended route through the surrounding fells instead.

The return route winds through a silent winter forest to a traditional kota. Warm yourself by the open fire, grill a Finnish sausage and enjoy hot berry juice before continuing the descent and returning to Levi with unforgettable memories.

After a short introduction, follow your guide on a 2-4 km hike through quiet woodland, with a short climb to a viewpoint where Lapland's white landscape opens up. On a clear day the fell panorama makes the uphill worthwhile. On a cloudy one, the forest is enough. The route is designed to balance soft activity with scenery, making it accessible yet rewarding.

After the hike, gather at a private lean-to shelter reserved exclusively for your group, with no other visitors nearby. Around the fire, grill Finnish sausages, sip hot berry juice and take time to warm up and absorb the silence. Your guide shares how animals use the land, how the light shifts from polar night into spring and what it means to live close to this landscape.

Part of the exhibition is indoors, and a larger section is outdoors on the slope of Levi Fell. Your host, Ante Aikio, will personally guide you through the museum, wearing a traditional Sámi outfit, playing the drum, and performing joik songs. He will also present his latest Lappish saga book, *Phantoms of the Fentlake*.

Outside, you'll find a small reindeer corral where you can feed the reindeer with lichen and take photos of the stunning fellside scenery.

Next, take the wheel of the Super Maverick X RS Turbo 4WD, built to handle snowbanks, skidding corners and jumps. For pure fun, test your skills on two unique challenges: the hilarious Funny Car, where steering is reversed, and the fast, agile Cross Car, built for winter racing.

Day-trip King Crab Safari, North Norway, Barents Sea
