Polarman's Camp + Snow Igloo Park Live

Discover Polarman's Camp, a private Arctic retreat just 10 minutes from Levi. Escape the crowds under a nearly 360° unobstructed sky, free from light pollution, and relax in our cozy Aurora dome.

Begin your journey with a warm welcome from the Polarman, settle by the open fire on reindeer skins, and explore the camp's unique attractions. Join the Aurora Hunt - a guided riverwalk in search of Northern Lights. Capture the moment with our professional camera, framed by the magical arctic scenery.

Step into the Snow Igloo Park, built from November onward, featuring a grand igloo, Inuit igloos, a snow maze, children's snowslide, and more. Participate in a "Build Your Own Snow Igloo" masterclass or try a winter survival course inside the big igloo.

Relax in the warm Aurora dome (+15°C), enjoy hot drinks, cookies, and a 20-minute movie on Lapland's seven seasons. End your evening with an outdoor Lappish BBQ, roasting sausages and marshmallows around the fire while sharing Arctic stories.

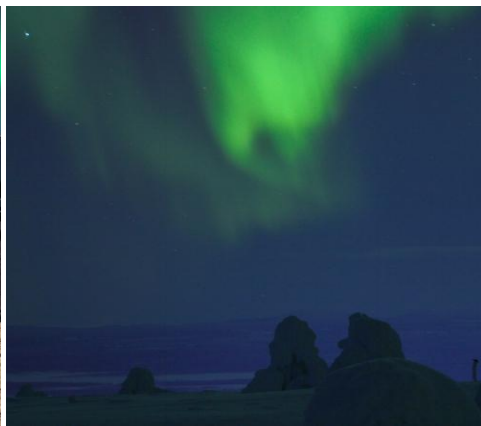

Lappish Meeting with a Shaman in a Hut

Just 40 minutes from Levi, on the edge of Pallas - Ylläs National Park, lies Lake Jerisjärvi. On its quiet shore in Keimioniemä village lives the Shaman of Lake Jerisjärvi, guardian of ancient northern traditions.

Inside a traditional Lappish kota, you sit on reindeer hides around an open fire. Stuffed ravens and a watchful boreal owl add to the mystery, as flames flicker and the Shaman enters backwards in ritual custom. Clad in fur, leather and skins, he shares an Arctic tale, performs a drumming ritual, and offers each guest a personal blessing.

The ceremony ends with coffee brewed by the fire and blueberry pie from the Shaman's own hand-picked berries. On clear evenings, the Aurora may illuminate the lake and fells in this private, authentic setting.

For daytime tours, lunch can be added: either a warm pike sandwich or fisherman's soup with bread, both served by cousin Jari as stories continue by the fire.

The Shaman is also available for off-site visits for groups or special occasions (dinner not included).

Lappish Evening with a Shaman in a Hut with dinner

Just 40 minutes from Levi, on Lake Jerisjärvi's tranquil shore by Pallas-Ylläs National Park, lives the Shaman of Jerisjärvi. In a traditional kota, you sit on reindeer hides by the fire as the Shaman enters backwards in ritual custom, dressed in fur and leather. He shares Arctic tales, performs a drumming ritual, and offers each guest a personal blessing.

Outside Christmas, the evening continues with dinner served by cousin Jari in a more relaxed atmosphere. Three menu choices:

- Festive Reindeer (soup, sautéed reindeer, potatoes, cheese with cloudberry, coffee)
- Festive Fish (mushroom soup, fried local fish, mashed potatoes, cheese with cloudberry, coffee)
- Reindeer Stew (smoked stew, blueberry pie, coffee).

On clear nights, the Aurora may dance above lake and fells. The Shaman is also available for off-site visits (without dinner).

Traditional Winter Net Fishing & Fish Soup by the Fire

Just 40 minutes from Levi, on the edge of Pallas-Ylläs National Park, lies tranquil Lake Jerisjärvi. On its quiet shoreline in Keimöniemi village, a local fisherman welcomes you into the rhythm of Arctic life.

Outfitted in warm winter gear, you step onto the frozen lake, surrounded by snowy fells. The fisherman reveals juomustus - an ancient method of winter net fishing once vital for survival. Before reaching the nets, you'll see how they are laid beneath the ice with simple traditional tools.

Then comes the moment of truth: the cork line quivers and silver whitefish glimmer beneath the ice. Jerisjärvi's clear waters are famed for their whitefish catch, and the thrill awakens even first-timers.

Afterward, retreat to the warmth of a kota. By the fire, enjoy freshly prepared fish soup, followed by coffee and homemade blueberry pie. As you savor Lapland's wild bounty, the fisherman shares legends and tales passed down through generations.

More than fishing, this is a cultural journey into Lapland's heart.

Traditional Summer Fishing in Lappish Lake Scenery & Smoked Whitefish Lunch by the Fire

Just 40 minutes from Levi, on the peaceful shores of Lake Jerisjärvi, lies Keimiöniemi - home to Jari and his family, who have lived and fished here since the 1830s. This authentic summer experience invites you to discover traditional Lappish lake life in a breathtaking setting.

Your day begins at Jari's home, followed by a short walk to the shore. A boat trip takes you to the historic Keimiöniemi fishing huts, where Jari, a master storyteller, shares tales of lake life past and present.

Back on the private shore, you'll learn traditional seine fishing. The net is taken onto the lake by two boats while others watch from a rowing boat or by the fire, admiring the fell scenery. As the seine is pulled in, guess the catch before the fish are gutted and smoked on-site.

Once the whitefish turns copper in the smoke, it's time for your lakeside lunch—eaten by hand as locals have for generations. Dessert is coffee brewed on the fire and homemade blueberry pie with berries handpicked by the family.

A genuine Lappish moment where history, nature, and taste unite.

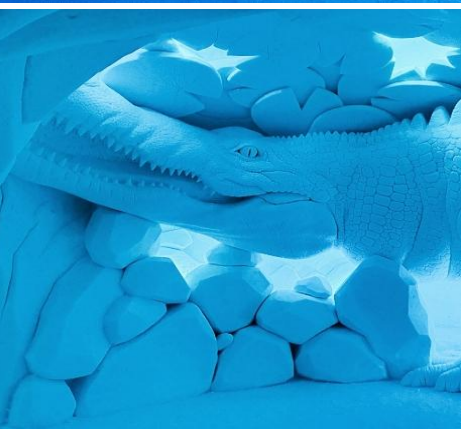

Visit to Lainio Snow Village

Just 40 minutes from Levi lies the enchanting Snow Village - an ephemeral world built anew each winter from snow and ice. On a guided tour you'll wander glittering corridors, themed chambers, dazzling sculptures, and the iconic ice bar. A warming juice awaits at the end, before time to explore freely at your own pace.

Each season unveils a new artistic theme: from Game of Thrones to Macro World, Futuristic, Around the World, Nordic Mythology, and Underworld.

Optional lunch experiences:

- A relaxed soup buffet in the Glass/Log Restaurant, with hearty daily choices of meat, fish, or vegetarian soups, served with fresh bread and coffee or tea.

Visit to Lainio Snow Village with dinner in ice restaurant

Just 40 minutes from Levi, your evening begins with a three-course dinner in the spectacular Ice Restaurant - dining at sculpted tables and chairs within shimmering snow and ice. After dinner, a guided tour reveals the Snow Village: themed rooms, glittering corridors, dazzling sculptures, and the iconic ice bar, where warming juice is served. You'll then have time to explore at leisure before returning. Each year brings a new theme, from Game of Thrones to Macro World, Futuristic, Around the World, Nordic Mythology, and Underworld.

Dinner menu (2025-2026)*:

- Starters: Lapland delicacies in tapas style (reindeer, fish, farm cheese, vegetables, berries), cauliflower soup with apple & Västerbotten cheese, or scallops with citrus, pea & mint.
- Mains: Reindeer two ways, sautéed reindeer with mash & pickles, fried pike perch with beurre blanc, puikula potato gnocchi with spruce tip cream, or signature salad with squeaky cheese or salted rainbow trout.
- Desserts: Snowball of lingonberry & white chocolate, or cloudberry parfait with citrus and caramel.

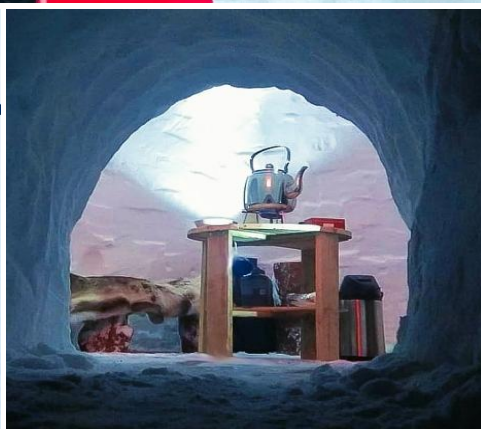

Build your own Snow Igloo (Winter survival in the wilderness masterclass)

Dressed in a thermal suit, safari boots, and mittens, you'll be transported into the Arctic wilderness—by a riverbank or frozen lake. Here you'll learn how to survive a snowstorm the traditional way: by building a real snow igloo. Guided by a wilderness professional, your team works together with shovels to create a shelter, gaining unforgettable skills. The program requires normal physical condition and moderate cold resistance, and can be run in nearly any winter weather.

Building spots lie in beautiful Lappish nature, and some igloos from this program are later preserved in our Snow Igloo Park in Levi, open for other visitors to admire. Your names and country can be displayed on the igloo's signpost. Around the fire, enjoy warm drinks and snacks, and if you wish, try snowshoeing nearby with tips from your guide.

Optional: Arrive by snowmobile safari. After gearing up, briefing, and exclusive 1.5–2h ride on private trails through snowy forests and lakes, you'll reach the igloo site. The adventure ends with car transfer back to your accommodation.

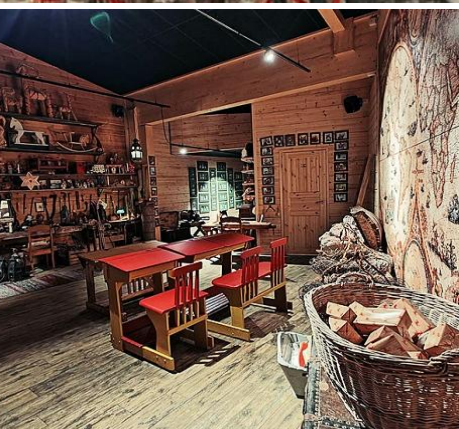
Meeting with Santa at his New House in Elves Village, Levi

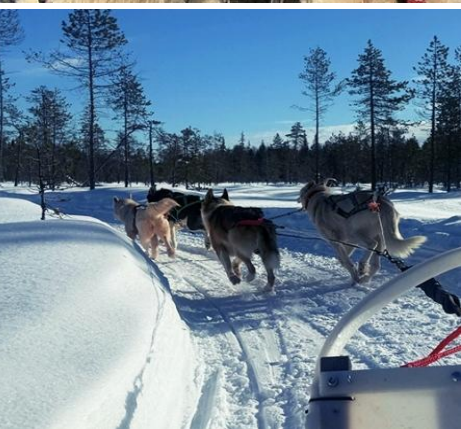

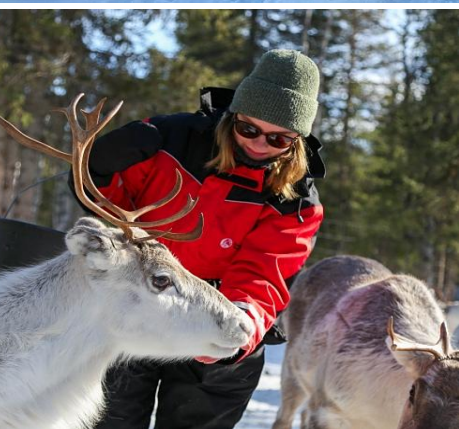

After a safety briefing, your guide leads you into the night, engines humming as you ride snowy trails across frozen wetlands, through silent forests, and over wide-open fields beneath the endless Arctic sky. The journey is pure magic — moonlight shimmering on untouched snow, constellations glittering above, and on clear nights the aurora weaving luminous ribbons across the horizon.

A highlight of this safari is access to private trails reserved solely for our guests. With no other groups around, you can embrace the silence, the vastness, and the rare feeling of Arctic isolation as your snowmobile glides deeper into the wilderness.

Midway, arrive at a wilderness kota set on a frozen swamp with 360° views to the north. Far from light pollution, it is one of Levi's finest vantage points for Northern Lights watching. Step inside to warm by the fire, grill a sausage, and sip hot drinks as you gaze skyward, waiting for nature's greatest show.

Family Snowmobile Safari – with Mini Snowmobiles for Kids

This family-friendly safari combines a classic snowmobile ride with a mini snowmobile adventure just for children — creating one of Levi's most popular winter experiences for families.

Part 1: Snowmobile Safari

After gearing up at our safari house and receiving a safety briefing, adults drive their own snowmobiles while children ride safely in a sleigh pulled by the guide. The route covers about 25 km (1 hr), an easy and scenic journey through snowy forests and open landscapes — the perfect shared Arctic adventure.

Part 2: Mini Snowmobile Fun

Midway, stop at a private wilderness kota set on a frozen swamp. Here, children as young as 3–4 years (minimum height 100 cm) can drive their own mini snowmobiles on a prepared track under guide supervision. The wide, open terrain is secure and easy to navigate, giving kids a safe taste of snowmobiling.

While children ride, parents relax in the cozy kota by the fire, grilling sausages and enjoying hot drinks. Afterwards, the group reunites to continue the safari back to Levi.

Your destination is a secluded taiga lake, hidden far from crowds. Here your guide provides fishing gear and shows you how to drill a hole through the thick ice. Built for experienced riders only, the Adrenalin Safari is Levi's ultimate snowmobile challenge. No sleighs, no children — just speed, distance, and pure Arctic terrain. Solo snowmobiles are strongly recommended to fully enjoy the power, control, and freedom this tour offers.

Expect 40–60 km of riding (approx. 3 hrs), with routes tailored to snow and season. Your guide may lead you around Levi Fell or through the rugged Kåtkä and Pyhä fells, often using private trails that cut across untouched wilderness. Later in the season, conditions may allow a climb to the summit of Levi Fell, where panoramic views stretch all the way to Sweden.

This safari is about more: more distance, more speed, more raw Lapland adventure. Whether looping through deep forest trails or cresting dramatic fells, every ride is fast, demanding, and unforgettable.

Midway, stop at a private wilderness kota to warm up by the fire with hot drinks and a snack. On some routes, you may also visit a remote wilderness café where traditional Lappish soup with bread is served (available as an optional extra).

Discover one of Lapland's most iconic winter landmarks on a guided snowshoe hike to Santa's Cabin — the legendary log hut atop Levi Fell, made famous in the Finnish Christmas film *Joulutarina*. This moderate-level adventure blends Arctic landscapes, soft activity, and magical photo stops at one of Finland's most Instagrammable sites.

Your journey begins in Levi village with snowshoe fitting before transfer to the Gondola base. Ride to the summit of Levi Fell, or if weather closes the lift, drive as high as possible and walk the final stretch. From the top, follow scenic trails across snowy ridges to the fairy-tale cabin, blanketed in white like a sugar-frosted house. Pause for photos, breathe the crisp Arctic air, and enjoy sweeping fell views stretching to the horizon.

The return route winds through a silent winter forest, where your guide leads you to a traditional *kota*. Warm yourself by the fire, grill sausages, and sip hot berry juice — a simple Lappish luxury — before completing the descent and returning to Levi with unforgettable memories.

Step into the Arctic night on a private snowshoe adventure through forests, fells, and open snowy landscapes — with the chance to witness the Northern Lights. This flexible evening tour adapts to your preferences, fitness, and weather, ensuring the best possible route.

After meeting your guide in Levi and fitting your snowshoes, set out either directly from your accommodation or with a short transfer to the trailhead. The most popular option begins atop Levi Fell, where sweeping views and high, open terrain offer ideal conditions for aurora watching. Alternatively, a smaller fell nearby provides a quieter, sheltered path with an intimate feel.

After meeting your guide in Levi and fitting snowshoes, a short transfer brings you to private trails far from crowds. Walk 2–4 km at an easy pace through snowy forests and frozen swamplands, with scenic viewpoints ideal for photos.

Your hike leads to a secluded pine and birch forest owned by a reindeer herding family. Here, curious reindeer gather as you feed them hay and pellets, creating close encounters and authentic moments. Some approach, others remain shy — reflecting their semi-wild nature.

Afterwards, warm up inside a traditional kota. Lunch includes vegetable soup with rieska bread, reindeer sausage grilled over the fire, and crispy pancakes with berry jam and cream, served with pot coffee or herbal tea.

At a lean-to shelter, warm up by the fire with grilled sausage and steaming berry juice. A dry Arctic toilet is available. Surrounded by snow-covered forest and silence, this experience reveals the tranquil side of Lapland life.

Set out on a foraging adventure near Jeris Lake, on the edge of Pallas-Yllästunturi National Park. 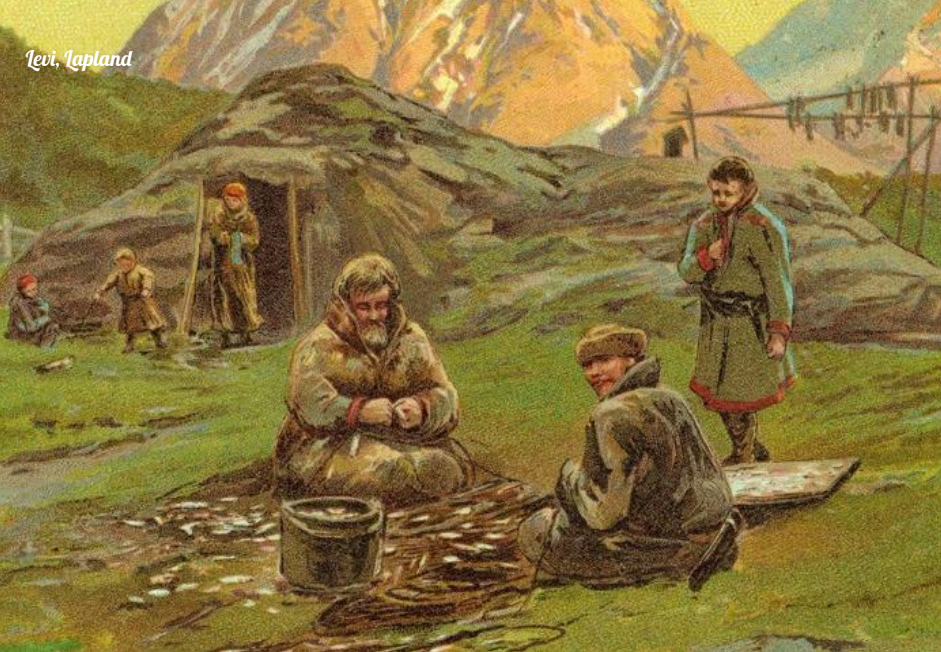

Visit to Samiland Museum

Levi Samiland Museum, under the patronage of UNESCO, introduces you to the lifestyle and culture of the last remaining indigenous people in Europe – the Sámi. The museum was built in 2011 by Mr. Ante Aikio, a descendant of the legendary Lappish shaman Kapin Jouni.

Part of the exhibition is indoors, and a larger section is outdoors on the slope of Levi Fell. Your host, Ante Aikio, will personally guide you through the museum, wearing a traditional Sámi outfit, playing the drum, and performing joik songs. He will also present his latest Lappish saga book, *Phantoms of the Fenslake*.

Outside, you'll find a small reindeer corral where you can feed the reindeer with lichen and take photos of the stunning fellside scenery.

PRIVATE program options:

Visit to Särestöniemi Arts Museum

The transfer from Levi center takes about 45 minutes. Upon arrival, you will enjoy a guided tour of the Särestöniemi Museum, exploring the home, studio, and gallery of the renowned Lappish artist Reidar Särestöniemi (1925–1981).

Särestö offers a peaceful atmosphere enriched with Lappish culture, history, architecture, art, and the traditional way of life. This unique setting tells the inspiring true story of Reidar, a farmer's son who, against all odds, rose to national and international acclaim as an artist. The museum area lies in the midst of nature along the banks of Lapland's longest river, the Ounasjoki, offering beautiful views in every season.

Arts Gallery

In 1972, Reidar Särestöniemi built his gallery to present his remarkable work to the public. Designed by acclaimed Finnish architects Reima and Raili Pietilä, the building reflects both the natural surroundings and the artist's personality. The main exhibition always features several colorful and striking works by Särestöniemi and changes once a year, while smaller exhibitions in the Studio and Old Särestö change every three months.

Info – Café – Shop

Conclude your visit in the museum's info and café house, where you will receive your tickets and brochure. Enjoy a warm beverage with a homemade sweet bun (included in the tour price) while soaking in the artistic atmosphere. The museum shop offers gifts and souvenirs that carry true stories and fine art.

Scenic Drive to Tuikku Panorama Restaurant on the Top of Levi Mountain

This short scenic drive is a perfect way to fill a daytime gap — for example after airport arrival and before accommodation check-in, or between a morning safari and lunch. Tuikku is Levi's oldest and most authentic mountain restaurant, famous for its panoramic setting at the summit and lively après-ski during the ski season. It's open seasonally and can be reached easily by car or taxi via the summit road.

On clear days, the views from Levi's top stretch across Western Lapland: you can spot nearby fells such as Aakenus, Ylläs, and Kätkä, and in the far distance the Pallas fells of Pallas-Yllästunturi National Park — a nationally celebrated skyline.

Tuikku offers a daily lunch buffet in season, coffee and pastries, and a fully licensed bar; in the evenings, the summit area is also a popular vantage point for Northern Lights when conditions are right (clear skies and low light).

Electric Fat Bike Trip with a Guide

Explore Levi's forests and fells on an electric fatbike, guided along trails tailored to your group. After a private transfer and bike fitting, your guide sets the pace and route for a 3–4 hour ride through Lapland's wild landscapes.

You'll wear your own winter clothing underneath, so there's no chill — just calm, silence, and snow-covered beauty all around.

Step into the water and let yourself float — effortlessly — among the stillness of the frozen landscape. Close your eyes, breathe the pure Arctic air, and feel your mind and body completely relax. Floating on a quiet lake, surrounded by snowy trees and stars (or even Northern Lights if you're lucky), more than 150 km above the Arctic Circle, is a rare and unforgettable experience.

Whether you're seeking something meditative, adventurous, or just totally different — this is a moment you'll carry with you long after your trip.

The savusauna (smoke sauna) is a traditional chimneyless sauna that many Finns consider a national treasure. Like a spiritual ritual, it's best understood by experiencing it: the gentle, enveloping heat and the scent of wood smoke create a deep sense of well-being known in Finnish as löyly.

Heating takes 5–6 hours. A large amount of wood is burned in an extra-large stove, filling the room with smoke. Once the sauna reaches temperature, the fire is allowed to die and the smoke is vented out; the stove's residual heat keeps the sauna comfortably warm for the entire session. The secret lies in the soft heat and the aroma of wood smoke. Soot-darkened walls and ceiling are characteristic, and good ventilation is essential so smoke can exit and fresh oxygen can enter.

The sauna sits on the shore of Lake Immeljärvi. The complex includes two separate changing rooms, each with its own toilet. One of the changing rooms also serves as a relaxation lounge after the sauna, complete with a fireplace and table. On the outdoor terrace, there is an authentic hot tub and a maintained ice hole for refreshing dips between steams.
