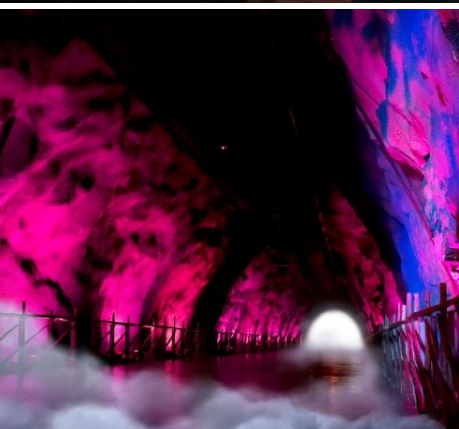

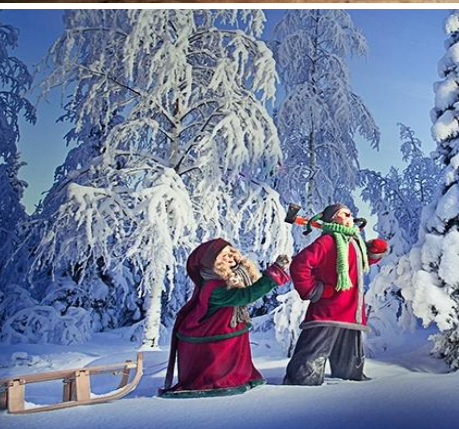

Outside, gather by the firepit for a Lappish BBQ with sausages and marshmallows while stories of life in Lapland unfold. Throughout the evening our staff watch the skies, ready to call you out when the Aurora appears — capturing unforgettable photos of you beneath the dancing lights.

Travelling by comfortable minivan or minibus, your experienced local guide reads the skies and weather patterns to find the darkest, clearest spots up to 50 km from the city — where stars shine brightest and the chances of seeing the Northern Lights are highest.

Midway, pause at a wilderness kota, a traditional Lappish shelter warmed by firelight. Here the hush of the snowy forest surrounds you as you sip hot drinks, taste gingerbread cookies, and grill sausages over open flames — a simple, authentic Arctic tradition. Your guide shares stories and legends of the Aurora, blending science, myth, and personal tales.

With mobility and expertise on your side, you follow every chance for clear skies, turning the hunt for the Aurora into an atmospheric adventure under the northern stars.

## Northern Lights Check by Car “Lite” (no fire, no kota)

This program increases your chances of spotting the Aurora by going outside Rovaniemi area (within maximum 50 km from Rovaniemi center).

We provide you with comfortable transportation with an experienced driver - either a minivan or minibus. We will be driving around 30 minutes out of Rovaniemi to search for unobstructed Northern hemisphere sky view and minimum light pollution, hoping to spot the Northern Lights.

Clouds can make it difficult to see the Northern Lights. Clouds can have different thickness, and wind can significantly change the cloud cover quickly, therefore sometimes even in cloudy weather, we still have chances of seeing the Lights or a glimpse of it through the opening in the sky and even through the clouds. It takes knowledge of the local weather, patience and pursuance. The driver will offer you a warm drink and gingerbread cookies during a stopover.

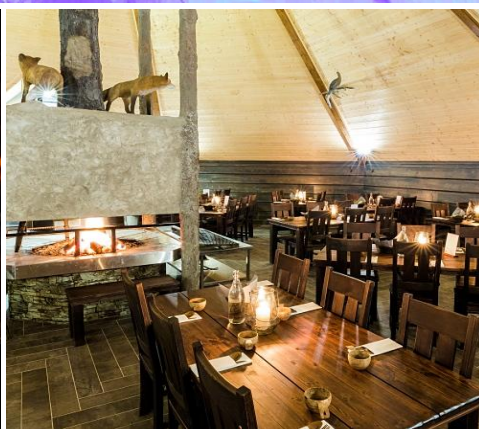


## Visit to Snow Hotel & Castle with Private Dinner in Teepee (kota)

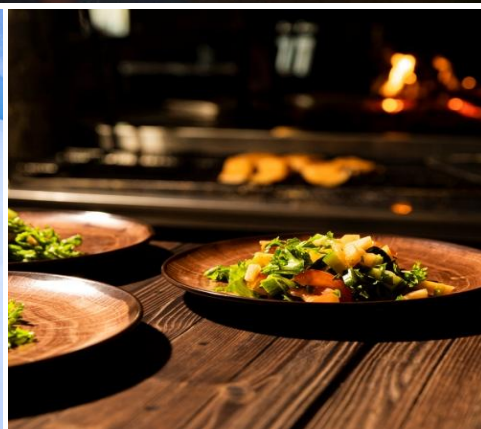

## Trip to Arctic Zoo Ranua with lunch

## Husky Safari in Hidden Forest – Self-Drive 2 km & Husky Cuddles

Just 15 minutes from Rovaniemi lies a family-run husky kennel hidden in peaceful forest, home to around 50 well-loved Siberian, Alaskan-Arctic, and reindeer dogs. On arrival, professional mushers welcome you personally and introduce you to your sled team. After a short lesson in braking, balance, and speed control, you set off on a 2 km self-driven safari through snowy trails. The ride lasts about 15 minutes, with the option to switch drivers or pre-book a musher-driven sled.

After the run, spend time meeting and thanking your dogs, then join a guided walk through the kennel to hear stories of husky life and care. A highlight is entering the free-run area, where selected huskies roam freely — perfect for play, photos, and heartfelt connection.

The visit ends in a cosy yurt hut with berry juice and homemade cookies by the fire, while your hosts share tales of the North. With an unrushed, dog-first approach, every wagging tail and joyful howl reflects the deep bond between husky and musher.

## Extended Husky Safari in Hidden Forest – 5 km Self-Drive & Husky Cuddles

Just 15 minutes from Rovaniemi lies a family-run kennel hidden in snowy forest, home to around 50 well-loved Siberian, Alaskan-Arctic, and reindeer dogs. On arrival, professional mushers welcome you and introduce your sled team. After a short lesson in braking, balance, and control, you set off on a 5 km self-driven safari. 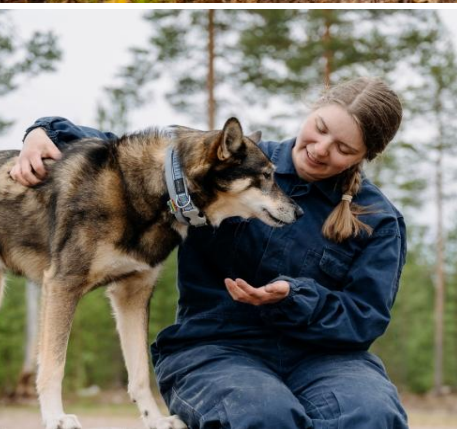

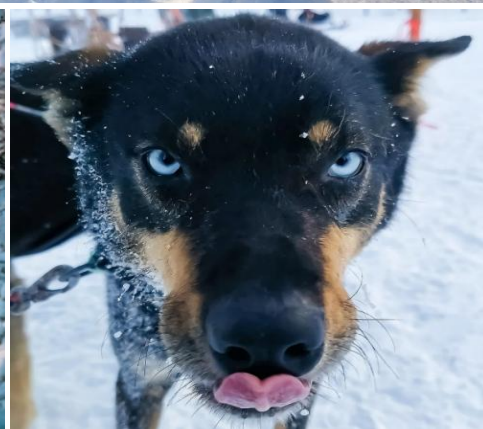

## Ice Karting Private Competition

Your adventure begins with private transfers and your own guide. Just 10 minutes from Rovaniemi, the ice karting track offers the perfect setting for adrenaline and fun. After a safety briefing and fitting into full winter-racing gear — helmet, hood, shoes, gloves, and overalls — you'll take the wheel of go-karts equipped with studded tires and quiet four-stroke engines.

The 300 m track, edged with snow banks and tires, features sharp corners and straights for drifting and acceleration. An open fire by the track provides warmth, hot berry juice, and the perfect spot to cheer on friends.

The competition begins with practice laps (approx. 5 minutes per driver), followed by timed qualification laps. The top three qualify for the finals, where speed and skill decide the winner. With 5–6 karts on the track at a time, everyone enjoys 10–20 minutes of pure racing excitement.

Whether drifting into corners or chasing faster lap times, this is Arctic adrenaline at its best.

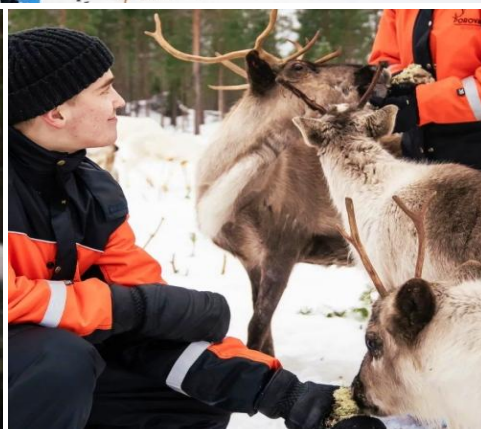
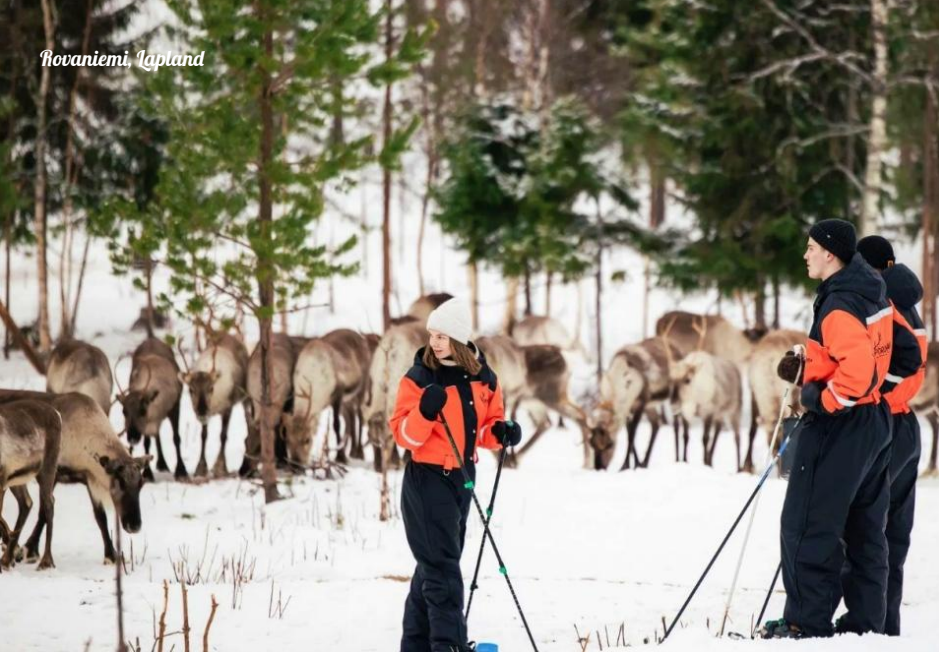

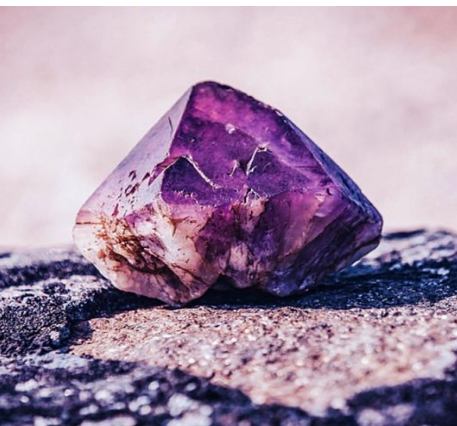

## Luosto Amethyst Mine

Travel about 1.5 hours from Rovaniemi to Luosto for a visit to the Lampivaara Amethyst Mine, where gemstones formed over 2,000 million years ago. From the base of the fell, board the Amethyst Pendolino — a heated snow train pulled by a snow vehicle — and ride up to the summit for sweeping views over Pyhä-Luosto National Park.

After a short introduction, your guide will take you to the open digging area, partly roof-covered so searching is possible even in winter. Learn the geology of the region and dig for your own personal “lucky amethyst,” a hands-on highlight that combines discovery with Arctic scenery. Before heading back, visit the Amethyst Shop, where locally mined stones are crafted into jewellery and unique gifts.

Seasonal note: In winter/spring (Nov–Apr), access is by Amethyst Pendolino snow train; in summer/autumn (Jun–Oct), you reach the starting point by car.

## Trip to Korouoma Frozen waterfalls

Set out by minibus for Korouoma Canyon in Posio, about 1h 20min from Rovaniemi, to explore one of Lapland's most dramatic winter landscapes. Your guide leads a ~1.5 km hike to the frozen waterfalls, a moderately challenging trail with 220 m of elevation and ~40 minutes of walking. The path descends into a 30 km fracture valley, where towering cliffs create breathtaking curtains of ice. Known as Finland's #1 ice-climbing destination, Korouoma is also a paradise for photographers.

At the falls, pause to admire the frozen cascades, warm up by a fire, and enjoy snacks and hot drinks. The silence of the canyon is broken only by the crackle of flames or, with luck, the call of wildlife — reindeer, moose, or even a red fox.

This excursion is best suited for adults and older children with basic fitness. The combination of canyon scenery, frozen waterfalls, and untouched nature makes it one of the most unforgettable winter day trips from Rovaniemi.
